I'm Doctor Alan Whitehouse, a specialist in pulmonary medicine in Spokane, Washington.

For several years I have been diagnosing and treating people from the Libby area who have asbestos-related illness.

The Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry is now contacting those people living within two and a half miles of Libby town center to make appointments for testing to identify asbestos-related health effects.

You are eligible for this free testing if you lived, worked, played, or went to school in the Libby area for at least 6 months before December 31, 1990.

You are also eligible for the asbestos testing if you are a former employee or family member of an employee of a Libby area W.R. Grace or Zonolite operation.

All test results are held in confidence and on your request will be given to a private physician.

When you're called for an appointment, please say yes to the test.

I'm Doctor Alan Whitehouse. As you may know, I'm an independent physician who treats patients with lung-related diseases. For some time I have been treating people from Libby who have asbestos-related illnesses.

The Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry, or A-T-S-D-R, a part of the Department of Health and Human Services, is now working in Libby to help identify those who may have health effects from exposure to asbestos.

To ensure an accurate reading of the x-ray portion of the testing, A-T-S-D-R has arranged for each x-ray to be reviewed, in confidence, by Dr. Becker, or another local radiologist, as well as several other independent experts. I'll also be available to review any films of concern.

A-T-S-D-R is working to provide you confidential, accurate and reliable information about your health.
