

Authorization



- The Federal Surplus Personal Property Donation Program through GSA (www.gsa.gov) enables certain nonfederal organizations to obtain personal property that the federal government no longer needs.
- The Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended, provide for the transfer of surplus personal property to State Agencies for Surplus Property (SASP)



Option One - Donations

- GSA authorizes SASPs to donate Federal Property to non-profit educational activities and others
- After Registering with your State Agency for Surplus Property you become an “Eligible Recipient”
- Excess Federal property can then be obtained from any Federal Agency
- Re-registration is required annually
- College is responsible for all shipping charges

NOTE: The donating Federal Agency will transfer the property to the SASP free of charge, but the SASP may charge the educational institution an administrative fee!

Option Two – Donations

- The United States Department of Energy (DOE), in accordance with its responsibility to encourage research and development in the energy area, awards grants of used Energy-Related Laboratory Equipment (ERLE). Universities, colleges and other non-profit educational institutions of higher learning in the United States are eligible to apply for equipment to use in energy-oriented educational programs in the life, physical, and environmental sciences, and in engineering.
- Colleges can screen and apply for available equipment on-line. Equipment is donated at no cost, but is responsible for any transportation costs.

How to Screen

<http://erle.osti.gov/erle/index.asp>

- Step 1: Screen for equipment
- Step 2: Complete on-line application for equipment
- Step 3: Review and approval by the DOE Property Mgmt Officer (14 days)
- Step 4: Grant is approved if property is available
- Step 5: The College contacts the donating organization within 1 week. (Note: College is responsible for any shipping charges.)
