**Weekly Stipend:** Faculty—\$1,200, Graduate Students—\$700, Undergraduate Students—\$600

**Housing Allowance:** Faculty—\$1,500, Students—\$1,000

**Travel Allowance:** One round trip to Center for participants who live more than fifty miles, one-way, from their assigned Center

**Follow-on Funding:** Up to \$50,000 in Follow-on funding may be awarded to faculty to continue research and collaboration efforts with the DHS Center for the 2015-2016 academic year
