Hanford Incident Command System

An integrated emergency management system with clearly defined responsibilities and communication pathways that allows assigned and trained individuals to jointly determine and implement incident mitigation strategies




Hanford Incident Command System



- Hanford ICS mirrors the nationally recognized ICS model
- Structure provides for graded approach for emergency management based on needs of the event
- Integrates Hanford Patrol and Hanford Fire Department with the Facility Emergency Response Organization
- The senior responding Hanford Fire Department Officer will be the Incident Commander for non-security events

★ Typically staffed by facility personnel.



Unified Incident Command System

Unified Command established for security events

- Hanford Patrol maintains control of security related concerns
- Hanford Fire Department maintains control of fire, medical, and hazardous material concerns
- Integration of Tactical Support Group



Unified Incident Command System

Tactical Support Group (TSG)

- The TSG is a modular organization designed to matrix to and support the Hanford Patrol Incident Commander during a security emergency.
- The TSG supports the Incident Command Post (ICP) by gathering and managing information, and by developing and coordinating tactical options that may be exercised by the Incident Commander.
