

Exercise "Swift Sticker" Design Guidelines

Limitations

1. The exercise will not last longer than 60 minutes.
2. The plant population will not be impacted by this exercise.
3. Off-site organizations will not be notified as part of the exercise.
4. Plant operations will not be impacted by the exercise.

Protocols

1. The standard Einsteinville exercise protocols are in effect.
2. Ensure that the use of "This is an exercise" is maintained during all exercise telephone and radio traffic.

Preapproved Simulations

1. A fire department representative will simulate the emergency response organization in the exercise simulation cell on the emergency response radio network.
2. Actors in the exercise simulation cell will simulate DOE Headquarters, the state 24-hour notification point, and local governments.
3. The initial 911 call will come from an actor pre-staged at the affected building.
4. The wind direction is from the south-southwest at 195 degrees; wind speed is 1.2 mph; and the temperature, humidity, and stability class are actual conditions. The 24-hour forecast is actual.
5. When the shift superintendent or control center staff begins to activate the ERO paging system, instruct them to explain the process.
DO NOT LET THEM ACTIVATE THE PAGING SYSTEM.
6. When the shift superintendent or control center staff begins to make the protective action public address announcement, have them read it to the evaluator.
DO NOT MAKE THE PA ANNOUNCEMENT.
7. An exercise telephone directory will be issued to the shift superintendent and control center staff with the "Exercise Only" telephone and fax numbers for all organizations on the notification form.
