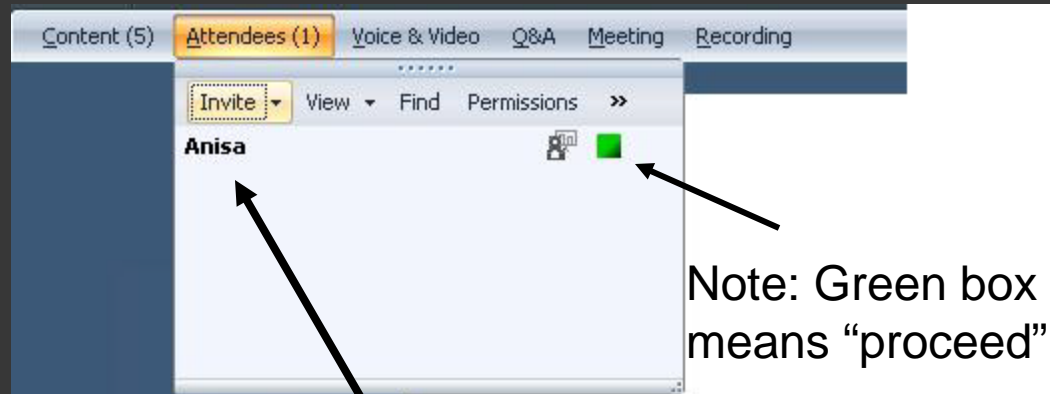
Q&A and Raise Your Hand

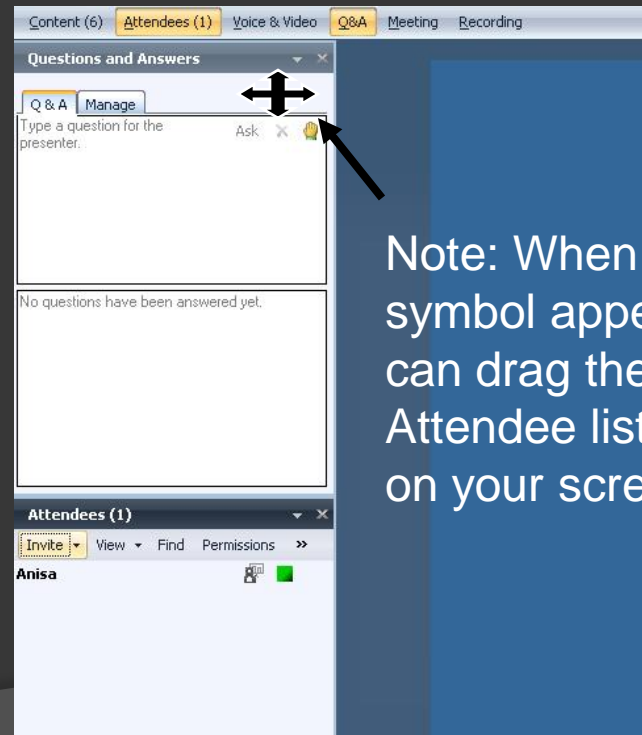

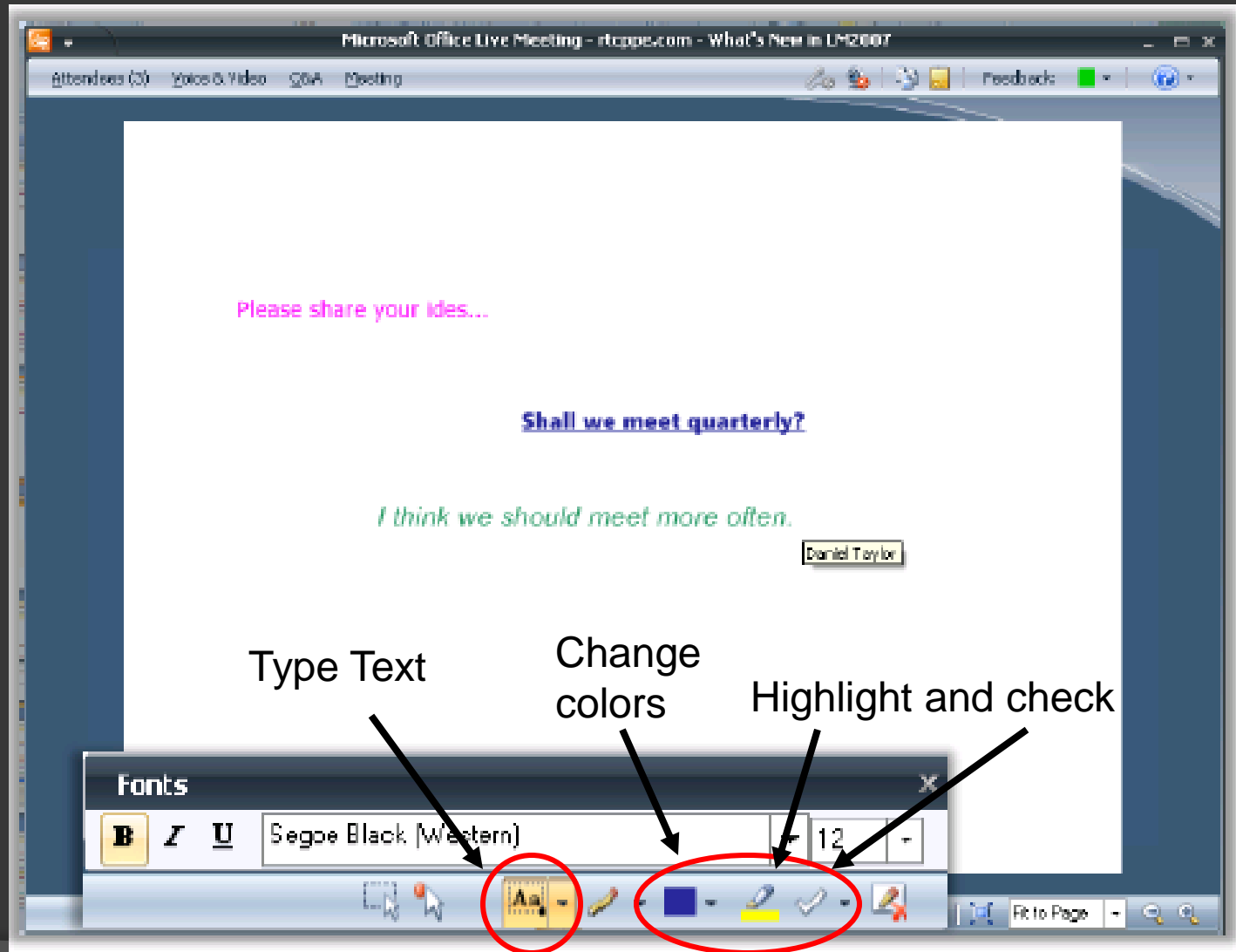



To me, a good flipchart has **colors**, neatly presents the information, the type is not too small and I use it as an *aid* (not something I rely on and read when teaching). Its easy to talk to a flip chart but as instructors, we need to remember the flip chart is just another **visual tool** to help convey our message.

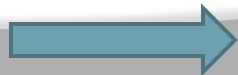
