Course Name: EM CONTRACT MANAGEMENT

Description: This course is designed for EM Executives who are often involved in contract related decisions, but who are not formally trained as contracting officers. These individuals are typically Site Managers, Deputy Site Managers, Headquarters Office Directors, Deputy Office Directors, Program Managers, Federal Project Directors, or individuals destined to be assigned to these positions.

Content: Course content includes current and relevant acquisition contract management issues within EM.

This course is structured to provide a practical, working-level understanding of contract management concepts by using standard classroom presentations along with a case study methodology. Within this course, case studies present real world examples of the topics examined. Case studies also illustrate acceptable and unacceptable implementation of contract management concepts as interpreted by oversight organizations, such as the GAO and the US Court of Federal Claims.

Case studies are selected from:

1. EM's library of case studies,
2. GAO Protest decisions,
3. Civilian Board of Contract Appeals decisions, and
4. US Court of Federal Claims decisions
