Description: The Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Implementation Process is a 2.5-day course designed to provide participants with the knowledge to make existing buildings and new construction environmentally sound. This course supports the mandate of the Secretary of Energy who has directed that all projects meet the LEED Green Building Rating System green initiative goal standards. The course walks participants through the phases of a typical project, using case examples and implantation strategies throughout to reinforce learning and encourage participants to apply knowledge to real-life situations. Topics covered include climate change and building impacts, motivators for green building, and the history of the green building movement.
