**Description:** Project Leadership/Supervision is part of the Project Management Career Development Program (PMCDP). It is required for PMCDP Level 2 certification. This course is designed to stimulate long-term project management leadership growth by addressing leadership principles and styles; identifying individual strengths and weaknesses; developing supervision and motivation techniques; building integrated project teams; and organizing and motivating team members.

Objective: The objective of this course is to develop a working-level knowledge of leadership principles, supervision and motivation techniques, conflict resolution techniques; and integrated project teambuilding skills in a project environment.

REQUIREMENT: To earn course credit, participants must attend all sessions and complete all course assignments, including successful completion of course exams.

**Audience:** Level 2 or higher Federal project directors; integrated project team members; and prospective project directors. Attendees at this course should have 5 years experience in project management and should currently be in a project management position on a project with a total project cost of 20 to 100 million dollars.
