Description: This course is part of the Project Management Career Development Program (PMCDP). It is an elective for PMCDP Level 2 certification. The course focuses on the Value Management (VM) process. This course addresses building and leading VM teams; understanding the 6-step VM job plan; VM definitions, principles, and concepts; contractual aspect of VM; VM and the project life cycle; and function analysis in the VM process. NOTE: Value Management is not Earned Value Management. This is not a course on Earned Value Management Systems (EVMS).

Objective: This course provides participants with an understanding of the Value Management process, emphasizing the modern approach to VM and how it can best be applied in the project life cycle to reduce the cost and schedule of DOE projects.
