**Cyber Snapshot:** In support of criminal investigations, administrative inquiries, security matters, and counterintelligence investigative activities, the Cyber Forensic Laboratory is responsible for conducting detailed forensic examinations of digital media using sound forensic analysis procedures. In addition to supporting DHS Headquarters investigations, the Cyber Forensic Laboratory conducts forensic examinations for other components across the DHS enterprise.

**OCSO** is especially interested in students that have completed coursework or previous work assignments related to digital forensics and cybercrime investigations. Assignment in the Cyber Forensic Laboratory will give students exposure to multiple industry standard digital forensic tools and the ability to obtain hands-on experience conducting forensic examinations.
