NRL is the corporate research laboratory for the Navy and Marine Corps and conducts a broad program of scientific research, technology and advanced development. NRL has served the Navy and the nation for 90 years and continues to meet the complex technological challenges of today's world. NRL is a campus-like complex of diverse scientific facilities, with a staff of more than 2,500 researchers, engineers, technicians and support personnel. Overall Laboratory management is under the direction of a Navy officer and civilian research director. The internal organization is organized into five directorates, four of which conduct scientific research, and the Naval Center for Space Technology.

While NRL does not provide monetary housing assistance, we do keep a list of possible housing options in the area. This list includes university housing options, private citizens offering a room or home/apartment for rent, student housing assistance sites and more. NRL's point of contact will assist students with housing needs when possible, but ultimately, students are responsible for making their own arrangements.

NRL does not require a parking pass, and lab parking is abundant and free of cost. Public transportation is available via bus (there is no direct Metro Rail Access). Some methods of public transportation are listed along with housing possibilities.

On-campus eateries include Dominic's of New York Café and Sundries Shop, and Subway. There is also a campus Shuttle Bus Service.
