 - **Communication Channels are like Analog Lines**
 - **Minimal Support of Government Programs by each Country**
 - **Intelligence Information Paranoia, Exaggerations**

- **Private Industry with Governments**
 - **Analog Communications Lines**
 - **Political Red Tape – Site Based Management**
 - **Consulate Support Minimal / Basic / Request**
 - **Criminal Activity Data Reports not accurate (Mexico)**
 - **Minimal Outreach and Cooperation Programs – Site Based Management in Ports.**
