I can see the employees gathering at the assembly station. The assembly station is not in danger from the gas. I have established an initial 300-meter isolation zone around the scene. Security has the roads blocked. The assembly station is just outside the isolation zone.

I am suiting up an entry team and will send them in to attempt to stop the leaks. I do need industrial hygiene support ASAP.
